


Meadowthorpe Neighborhood Association
General Membership Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, August 9, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.
333 Larch Lane

- I. The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. Vice President Bill Congleton and Treasurer Linda Melton were present.
- II. The minutes of the July meeting and the printed agenda for the August meeting were unavailable for review and approval.
- III. Lt. Daughtery gave a summary of criminal activity in the neighborhood.
- IV. Sharon Murphy of Councilmember Akers' office gave information regarding panhandling.
- V. Recognition of guests and presentations
 - A. Roger Mulvaney, P.E., LFUCG Traffic Engineer, discussed the neighborhood traffic management program including cost sharing of installation of speed tables. He explained that an initial review of traffic issues in the neighborhood could take several weeks. Neighbors must petition a survey.
- VI. Committee report
 - A. Tom Blues and Coleman Bush gave the Plaza Committee project report. The budget for the project was outlined, including Councilmember Richard Maloney's allocation of \$2,000 toward the project. Tom Blues made a motion to sell pavers at \$25 per paver for residents and \$100 per paver for businesses to help fund the project and to release the reserve funds of \$800 to be spent directly on the project. Coleman Bush seconded. Motion carried.
 - B. No other committee reports were given.
- VII. New business
 - A. Sasha Love-Higgins, candidate for 2nd District Council, announced a community baby shower and a community beauty pageant.
 - B. Traci Letcher discussed ideas for improving the area in front of the strip mall on Leestown Road and on Antique Drive.
 - C. Vice President Bill Congleton reported that neighborhood residents hung a "thin blue line" flag on the Boiling Springs flagpole with the United States flag and requested neighborhood approval to continue flying the flag. Brian Throckmorton made a motion to fly only the U.S. flag on the neighborhood entrance flagpole. Brenda Coleman seconded. Motion carried.
- VIII. Tom Blues made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Jim Stone seconded. Motion carried.
